Class 4: Devoted: The family of God.

Fellowship and the building of unity; the reality of family life – problems, perceptions, needs, wants, disagreements, weakness, grace, mercy, good will, wisdom, perseverance, and trust in God. Paul: choosing to do things to try to improve relations, acquiescing to do things to improve relations with people who have a wrong impression of him; keeping the focus on what is most important without ignoring the realities of life.

2. Devotion: Ac 2:41-47 - Defines character of the Church

Proskartereo: to persist in a thing, apply diligently to it; to endure, to persevere, to be strong or firm towards anything, to be constantly occupied or engaged in; to be continually in with or near any person or thing. 2:42, 45 Devotion is an individual choice; in what ways are you devoted?

3. The Holy Spirit in my life: God devoted to me

History bears witness to this confirmation: Origen (185-254)

"The Holy Spirit gave signs of His presence at the beginning of Christ's ministry. And after His ascension, He gave still more.

But since that time, these signs have diminished, although there are still traces of His presence in a few who have had their souls purified by the Gospel, and their actions regulated by its influence. 4.614.

That the time of confirming the message has passed does not mean that God has lessened his devotion to us, just that we are in a different period – similar to process in OT

4. The Holy Spirit in my life: Me Devoted to God

Acts 6:3-5 – Stephen: how did they recognize him as someone full of the Holy Spirit prior to his being able to do miraculous signs? Philip?

God is a God of process

Logikos – also used in Rom 12:1; rational, requires us to engage our brains

Devoted to the Apostles teaching

What Lessons should we take from this?

- 1. Devotion to God requires financial sacrifices Mt 6:24
- **2.** My financial giving is spiritual in nature; the Holy Spirit is intimately involved and aware of the attitude of my heart and the thoughts in my mind.

Devoted to giving Financially: Ac 2:45; NT examples: as needs arose, special collections

OT demonstrates both special collections and regular giving

Tabernacle; Temple; Tithing; Regular Sacrifices & Offerings

It was the regular sacrifices and offerings supporting priests and Levites in their full-time services

Had to correct those who took advantage of Church giving – 2 Th 3:7-15

Giving is a test of gratitude
