



Origen (185-254), writes: "The Holy Spirit gave signs of His presence at the beginning of Christ's ministry. And after His ascension, He gave still more. But since that time, these signs have diminished, although there are still traces of His presence in a few who have had their souls purified by the Gospel, and their actions regulated by its influence. 4.614.

God worked to confirm the message by signs and wonders and various miraculous and gifts of the Holy Spirit as he promised to do.

That the time of confirming the message has passed does not mean that God has lessened his devotion to us, just that we are in a different period – similar to process in OT

This doesn't mean that God is limited.

We are changed completely: but in what ways?

God is a God of process: he starts with a seed; he is the expert builder – Jesus the cornerstone.







#### **Devoted to Giving Financially**

The congregations supported churches in need Ac 2:45

Examples of giving in the NT include

- Regular tithing
- Regular sacrifices and offerings

#### There were issues to correct:

Paul had to correct those who didn't give and who were essentially moochers, living off of the church and using scripture to endorse their laziness 2 Th 3:7-15



<sup>9</sup> It is not that we don't have the right to support, but we did it to make ourselves an example to you so that you would imitate us. <sup>10</sup> In fact, when we were with you, this is what we commanded you: "If anyone isn't willing to work, he should not eat." <sup>11</sup> For we hear that there are some among you who walk irresponsibly, not working at all, but interfering with the work of others.



Jesus watched the widow put in 2 small coins – all she had to live on.

Large or small, making sacrifices and giving contributions is an integral part of our spiritual worship.

We are not commanded to give, but Jesus takes note of those who show gratitude

We are called to give cheerfully.

Contributions, are purely responses to how grateful we are for what God has done and is doing in our lives and how we understand our place before God.
